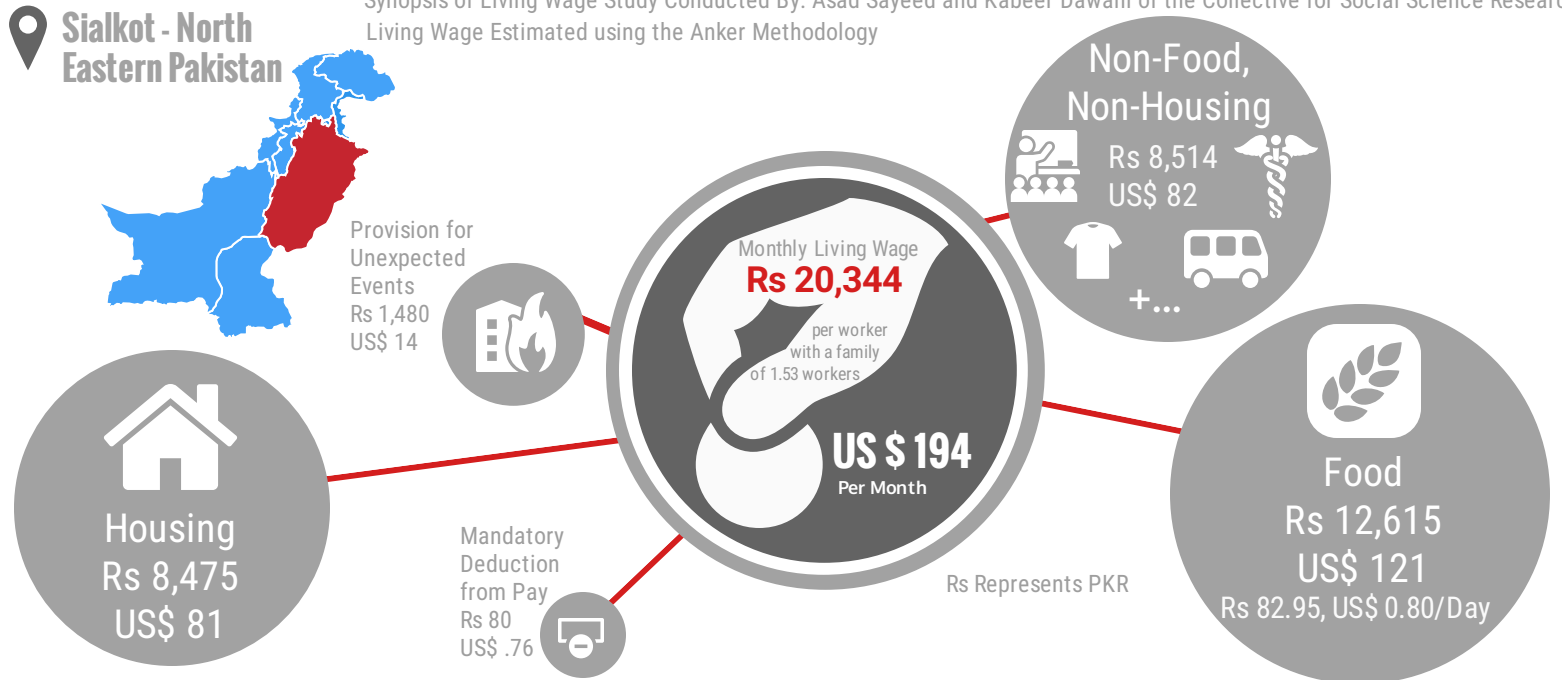

Local Housing Standard for Family of Four

- At least 50 sq. meters or 2 marla covered
- Walls, roof and floor made of permanent materials
- 2 bedrooms and separate room for kitchen
- 1 window per room for ventilation and light
- Pit or Flush Toilet

Model Diet

- 343g of wheat per day
- 25g of rice per day (once a week)
- 30g of lentils per day
- 58 g of potato per day
- 31g of tomato per day
- 41g of onions per day
- 30g of banana per day (1 banana on alternate days)
- 24g of chicken per day (twice a week)
- 3.6g of tea per day (3 cups for adults per day, 1 cup for children per day)
- 162g of milk per day (1 cup per day for children)

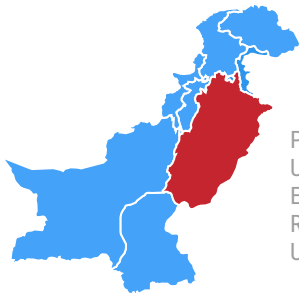

- 170g of milk per day (1 cup per day for children)

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
